**Title I:** Backman, Bennion, Edison, Escalante, Franklin, Jackson, Liberty, Meadowlark, Mountain View, Newman, North Star, Parkview, Riley, Washington, and Whittier Elementary Schools

**Non Title I:** Beacon Heights and Dillworth Elementary Schools

All classes are held Monday through Thursday. To be considered for the full day options at Franklin, Liberty and Mountain View, families must reside within the school boundaries. All other pre-school locations offer 3-hour sessions.

### Items Required for Registration

- ★ Parent or legal guardian's photo ID
- ★ Child's official birth certificate
- ★ Child's Immunization record
- ★ Proof of address (current utility bill, lease, etc.) (Verification of SLCSO boundary)
- ★ To see if you qualify for Title I reduced tuition you must present your 2016 Income Tax Return (1040 form) where your child's name is listed
- ★ Accepting state scholarship vouchers from Workforce Services
- ★ A **non-refundable** registration fee of \$20.00 for **Title I** or \$75.00 for **Non-Title I** in the form of **cash, check, money order, or credit card**
