

State Law and Policy Training Instructions

Human Sexuality

Utah State Law requires all new, or newly assigned, teachers who teach any aspect of human sexuality to complete the On-line Human Sexuality Law and Policy Course. All teachers are required to re-certify and re-take the course every three years. Teachers may take the course at their leisure and print the certificate when it is completed.

*“Human sexuality instruction or instructional programs” means any course, unit, class, activity or presentation that provides instruction or information to students about sexual abstinence, human reproduction, reproductive anatomy, physiology, pregnancy, marriage, childbirth, parenthood, contraception, or HIV/AIDS and other sexually transmitted diseases. While these topics are most likely discussed in such courses as **Health Education, Health Occupations, Human Biology, Parenting, Adult Roles, Psychology, Sociology, Child Development, and Biology**, this rule applies to any course or class in which these topics are the focus of discussion. (As per state law and policy.)*
